

TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1. The following rules plus USBC rules will govern all participants in this tournament.
- 2. Entrants will use their highest 22-23 USBC Certified League Yearbook Average at the end of winter, based on 21 or more games. If no winter league average, entrant shall use the highest summer average at end of 2023, of 21 games or more. Entrant may use his/her highest current league average, based on 21 games or more at time of bowling. All others will bowl scratch. USBC Rule 319A-2 (Ten-pin Rule) is waived. Pacers are not permitted. Bowlers with a right hand and left hand average will use the highest average. AVERAGE VERIFIED BY ASSOCIATION/LEAGUE SECRETARY OR YEARBOOK. No Sport Shot or Lucky 13 average.
- 3. Substitutions are permitted upon notification. In order for a substitute to be eligible for All Events, the sub must replace the original entrant in all 3 events and the transfer is made by the Tournament Official prior to the time of the substitute's participation IN ANY EVENT.
- 4. All bowlers will be required to initial averages submitted as correct prior to bowling first game. It shall be each bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain, or others. Failure to use proper averages, or make a correction prior to bowling, shall disqualify score (if submitted average is lower than actual average) prize winnings will be based on higher average.
- 5. YOU MAY BOWL TEAM EVENT AS MANY TIMES AS DESIRED. Not more than 3 players on the same team can place more than once in the prize list for Position Standings. First team event bowled counts on all events. Bowlers must enter both Singles and Doubles if entered in either event. The first time you bowl doubles you must also bowl singles. Your first doubles & singles entry will count for all events. You may not cash with the same partner more than once in the position standings. DOUBLES AND SINGLES MULTIPLE PARTICIPATION WILL BE PERMITTED ON ALL FRIDAY SQUADS 5:30 PM, SATURDAY 6:00 PM SQUADS. OTHER TIMES WILL BE BASED ON LANE AVAILABILITY. TEAM RE-ENTRY IS SATURDAY AT 6:00 PM.
- 6. The Entrants whose name appears hereon or their authorized replacements hereby agree that the Patricia Lanes Peanut Bowling Tournament, its Officers and Agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the Tournament due to premature termination of the Tournament, brought about by war, national emergency, or causes relating or resulting from fires, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the Patricia Lanes Peanut Bowling Tournament. Prize fund would be paid on a prorated basis of the entrants already bowled, at the time of the interruption, and there shall be no further liability of the Patricia Lanes Bowling Tournament.
- 7. Handicap will be based on 90% of 220.
- 8. Tournament Awards: the following tournament awards will be presented: Prize ration is 1:10 in Team, Doubles and Singles; 1:20 in All-Events. Prize fee returned 100%. Optional Team, Singles and Doubles Scratch prize fund can only be entered if already entered in the Handicap events. Optional Scratch prize fund for Team must include entire team and Optional Scratch prize fund for Doubles must include both partners.
- 9. Out of town bowlers will be given a time of preference.
- 10. No additional squad will be added after 5:00 on the last day of the tournament.
- 11. All entries close at midnight, October 28, 2023.
- 12. No entry will be accepted without entry fee, including fees for vacancy bowlers for which substitutes are request. Entry fees must be certified check, money order, or credit card. Entries using credit cards will be charged a 3.99% convenience fee, per transactions. Entries presenting a bad check will be charged \$45.00 to cover bank charges and expenses per bad check. Any entry fees received which are not honored by issuing authority must be rectified in full before entry can be accepted or said entry will be rejected and returned. No team or individual shall be entitled to a refund after entry fees have been received and dates assigned.
- 13. The Tournament Manager reserves the right to re-rate, prior to bowling of any three-game set, the average of any bowler whose entering average is not comparable to his past tournaments(s) average or does not reflect the bowler's true ability. If this re-rated average is not acceptable to the individual, the entry fee will be returned to the bowler. Bowler re-rated in accordance with USBC Rule 319 are not eligible for refund of entry fee. Any bowler who has accepted or rejected a re-rate for any tournament must notify the Tournament Manager.
- 14. USBC Rule 319-D in effect for all USBC members. Bowlers who have qualified for a prize of \$300.00 or more in any event in a tournament which has ended within the previous 12 month period, even though payment of prize has not been made, must report: actual score, position and amount won for possible re-rating. Any bowler who does not provide all tournament winnings & actual scores prior to bowling according to rule 319-D will be disqualified.
- 15. USBC Rule 319-E on re-rating covers USBC members.
- 16. Computer print-outs will be official scores and retained for 24 hours. Any error must be reported within that time. In case of scores lost through computer, rebowling will be required.
- 17. ONLY FEMALE bowlers can bowl in the Ladies Division and OPEN DIV WILL BE OPEN TO MALE & FEMALE BOWLERS.
- 18. All bowlers must be USBC members, or are eligible non-USBC members, may purchase an Associate Membership fee card for \$21.00.
- 19. In case of tie for first place in any event, co-champions will be declared. When ties occur, the prize money will be combined and divided equally among tied position winners.
- 20. Tournament Manager or committee reserved the right to accept or reject any or all entries and will decide all questions or disputes arising in the Tournament and their decisions will be final, subject to appeal to USBC Rule 329.
- 21. Employees of the house will be allowed to bowl in the tournament and shall be eligible for prizes. No more than three house employees on a team. No more than one house employee to a set of Doubles.
